The Retreat is a great place to host your next event and is typically used for private events, board meetings, social clubs, and social events. The Retreat has beautiful views of Red Rocks Amphitheater and the entire front range. The Pool

One of the more popular amenities in the community during the summer is the pool located next to The Retreat. The season starts on Memorial Day and ends on Labor Day. There is a capacity of 77 residents and guests in the pool area due to the size. We ask residents to limit their guests to 2 per day, Monday through Thursday and no guest on the weekends to accommodate residents. The hours are Monday through Sunday from 10am – 8pm throughout the summer.
